#### **Tuition Details**

- Tuition (\$750) will be paid in full when you register.
- Family members or a helpers cost \$375 for each additional person.
- Payment for the boat kit is due 30 days before the class begins.
- MD tax applies to boat kits purchased for Annapolis classes.

#### **If You Need to Cancel**

Students who cancel 15 days or less before the class begins will not receive refunds.

#### **If We Need to Cancel**

In the event of an emergency or a lack of registrations, Chesapeake Light Craft reserves the right to cancel classes and refund all tuition and boat kit money. Because of this policy, we strongly urge you to buy refundable airline tickets or flight insurance. Chesapeake Light Craft will not be responsible for any loss on nonrefundable airline tickets.

#### **Class Hours**

Classes start on Monday at 8 am. Building a boat in a week requires careful choreography! Please be on time. We'll take a full hour each day for lunch. Class will usually run until 5 or 6 pm, though some nights will be later. Classes end at noon on Saturday.

#### **Transporting Your Assembled Boat**

You'll need to get your boat home at the end of the class! Please be ready by Saturday to either cartop or trailer your boat home. CLC offers roof racks and trailers at excellent discounts; please let us know in advance what you need: 410 267 0137. It's possible to ship your boat home, though logistically complex---call us for more information.

#### **Outfitting Your Finished Boat**

Students in our classes will receive discounts on tools, supplies, and gear you might need to finish and outfit your boat.

#### **Tools**

We have enough equipment to loan to students who don't have or can't bring any tools, but you'll enjoy your experience more with a few basic tools of your own. Specific lists may be found on the web page for your class. We'd prefer you bring at least a cordless drill, basic hand tools, and as many clamps as you can manage.
